An exclusive development of 30 beautiful residential apartments located close to the river in Walton-on-Thames, London.

Box Architects were appointed by Farleigh Property in February 2017 to provide architectural and principal designer services for the development of Brassey House in Walton-on-Thames, an office to residential conversion, delivering 30 apartments.

Brassey House has a varied history and has in its time been converted from residential to offices (to aid the war effort, housing the British Petroleum Company offices, staff having been evacuated from central London) and then later on returned to residential.

Latterly having been converted to office use, and has even formed a key location for the successful acting partnership of Peter Sellars and Terry Thomas in the 1957 film the Naked Truth.

Planning permission has been received and site works are underway with Indigo Projects Ltd as contractor.
