A stunning new Bar and Restaurant at the renowned 4-Star, 17th Century Manor House, Weetwood Hall Hotel.

The four phased project includes a new bar, a new destination restaurant with an independent identity and a new entrance.

The completed project creates a double sided bar to serve the existing Woodlands function room and a second bar to serve the breakout area of the adjacent conference / function suites. The function room has been upgraded to include new breakfast serveries with feature sliding panels closing off the serveries when in function use.

A new state of the art kitchen has been installed with the capacity to serve both the existing function room and new restaurant.

The new restaurant has been created by extending the building into an existing underutilised garden space. The 120 cover restaurant has been

designed to reflect the contemporary Mediterranean theme, with an extensive external sunken terrace which benefits from a retractable roof and side enclosures to provide an all year round alfresco dining space.

A “processional” illuminated feature timber colonnade provides a wonderful sense of arrival for non-resident diners to emphasise the independent nature of the restaurant.
